As you might have read Brighton and Hove Albion F.C. have decided to play their 4th Round F.A. Cup match on Saturday 28th January kicking off at 5.15pm as the match will be shown on television.

This will cause some logistic problems with parking as the car park at the **Amex Stadium will not be available for car parking**. The football club has agreed that **coaches and minibuses** can be parked at their coach park next to the ground. However all vehicles must be removed by **3.30pm** on the Saturday afternoon to facilitate coaches and car arriving for the match. The football club will administer the parking which will cost **£15 per vehicle** paid on the day. Coaches who do not use this facility **must** take the coaches to the council's coach park on Brighton seafront at the east end of Madeira Drive and return at the end of the meeting.

Clubs using the parking facility are asked to unload and load up the passengers when they have parked in the coach park. Access to the park will be from the coach park via the bridge across the railway at Falmer Station and then the underpass to the Park.
