**Competitors** to get to the Stadium Car Park, leave A27 at Falmer, take slip road marked 'B2123 Rottingdean, Falmer', Follow B2123, after about 50yards straight across mini roundabout (B2123), another 50 yards turn right at traffic lights and right again into Stadium Car Park.

Pedestrians from the Stadium Car Park or Falmer Station : From the Car Park walk around stadium to the Station, cross over the railway line by the long ramp, down the steps, 30 yards turn left down more steps and walk under the underpass(A27) into Sussex University, 50 yards turn left and cross the Sports Hall Car Park. Registration and female changing in the Sports Hall. Cross the road and into Stanmer Park for the course and male changing.
